This violin is a true gem - a smaller full-sized instrument with a remarkable charm. Its fine tonal quality makes it ideal for a musician with smaller hands or a young prodigy still growing into a full-sized Stradivari model. The wood grain is exceptionally striking, further enhancing the uniqueness of this special instrument.
